CLIFF CEMETERY

This is a public cemetery and is accessible from the road.

Drive 10 1/2 miles west of Merna, Custer County, Nebraska on Hwy. 70/92, then 1 1/4 miles south. It is located next to the former site of the Cliff Union Church. The gate leading into the cemetery has the year 1886 imprinted on it. Inside the front gate is a monument that reads, "In memory of Cliff Union church 1909 - 1996. For where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them. Matthew 18:20
