This is a public cemetery and is accessible from the road. Travel 16 ½ miles north out of Broken Bow, Custer County, Nebraska on the county oil road or travel north ½ mile out of Gates, Custer County, Nebraska. The cemetery is located just north of the old site of Gates Post Office, Store and Schoolhouse.

(Metal Mortuary Signs were placed on unmarked burial sites, noted on early map, in 2021. Most Metal Signs are flat with the ground unless designated otherwise.) Noted with * in last column. Information is also available at Custer County Museum on research complete for the Marking of Unmarked Burial Sites Project. 2018-2021. Burial site, block, lot, space, of person is in cemetery records at the Custer County Museum in Broken Bow.

This does have some unidentified graves in the cemetery map that were ONLY notes with an X on the paper for burial sites. These are noted from the burial map, with (paid DEED) for ownerships.
