Mrs. Henry Lee and a daughter are buried on east from the 2 small children, daughters of the Ellingsons, in the area somewhat sunken and where these graves, plain and unmarked are cemented over.
Next or near to the grave of the Ottun twin is the grave of young Robert Ellingson, son of Mr. and Mrs. George Ellingson, who was killed when he was about 10 years of age when struck in the head by an unmanageable horse.
