

WALWORTH CEMETERY

This is a public cemetery and is accessible from the road.

On highway 183 go north of Sargent, Custer County, Nebraska for ½ mile, then go 9 miles west, 1 mile north, 1 ½ miles west and ½ mile north.

The Predmore Cemetery was a small family cemetery - located on the old Predmore homestead north of Walworth, Custer County, Nebraska.

Only one tombstone was left in the cemetery by 1969.

The following was on it.

Predmore, John C., March 14, 1834 - Aug 2, 1909;
Predmore, Nancy J., Apr 14, 1841 - Dec 23, 1892
Predmore, Clara R. Price, Nov 18, 1860 - Nov 17, 1894, (wife of Alexander Predmore, son of John and Jane) This is believed to be buried in this cemetery, but the graves are not marked.
Predmore, Lulu, 1870 - 1870, (daughter of John) This is believed to be buried in this cemetery, but the graves are not marked.
(The following babies were children of Benjamin, son of John and Nancy Jane Predmore)
Predmore, child, Oct 1, 1913 - Oct 1, 1913
Predmore, twin, (one died at birth), Oct 8, 1914 - Oct 8, 1914
Predmore, twin, Oct 8, 1914 - Apr 15, 1917
Predmore, Rosie Larue, Feb 11, 1915 - May 2, 1915
Predmore, twins, Apr 21, 1921 - Apr 21, 1921
Predmore, child, Oct 5, 1930 - Oct 5, 1930
